# **Psychiatry Training Rules and Regulations**

Students are obliged to comply with all the general rules and regulations regarding the Students of the Medical University of Lodz specified in the Student Guide.

#### Attendance

- 1. Students attend scheduled classes and lectures according to the timetable.
- 2. Attendance is checked on each lecture or class and confirmed by lecturers and clinical class teachers in **Student Individual Attendance Form**.
- 3. Students are requested to be at lectures and classes on time. That aspect of Students activity is an element of the final assessment and is included in the **Clinical Evaluation Form**.
- 4. Being late for more than 30 minutes is assumed as an absence from that lecture or class.
- 5. In case of an absence due to medical conditions, the student is required to present a formal medical leave. If medical leave is prolonged over 10% of the course attendance, the Student is entitled to apply for Dean's leave.
- 6. In case of max one unpredicted absence, the student has to make up for the missed classes in a way that is arranged with the tutor. The preferred option is to deliver a presentation (45 min.) on the omitted subject.

## Required procedures and activities:

- 1. Students' knowledge and acquired skills will be evaluated by clinical class teachers.
  - a. Students are obliged to prepare for classes according to teachers' assignments.
  - b. Students' knowledge will be periodically evaluated during classes.
- c. Students are obliged to prepare at least one written Psychiatric history and one Present Mental State Exam of the examined patients.
- d. Students have to pass multiple choice tests covering the following parts of psychiatric theory and practice:
  - I. General psychopathology
  - II. Psychotic disorders, mood disorders
  - III. Substance abuse disorders, anxiety disorders

Tests will take place on the following days of psychiatry training:

Test I: 22.05.2023 Test II: 26.05.2023 Test III: 01.06.2023

- e. Students who fail a test must retake it and pass it within **three days.** Clinical class teachers will be responsible for the retake.
- 2. The above procedures and activities are confirmed by clinical class teachers in the **Required Procedures Forms.**

### **Exam**

- 1. In order to receive the credit and be qualified for the exam, the Student has to:
  - a. Attend all the classes.
  - b. Pass all the tests and receive confirmation of required procedures.
- 2. Students meeting all the above requirements are allowed to take the multichoice exam.
